THIS APPEAL, made by the Plaintiffs/Appellants from paragraph 2 of the Order of the Divisional Court dated April 26, 2017 in Divisional Court File No. 556/15, dismissing the appeal on the Plaintiffs' "Umbrella Purchaser Claim", was heard on May 7, 2018 at the Court of Appeal for Ontario, Osgoode Hall, 130 Queen Street West, Toronto, Ontario, M5H 2N5, with reasons having been reserved until this day.

**ON READING** the Appeal Book and Compendium, Exhibit Books, Factum and Brief of Authorities of the Plaintiffs/Appellants and the Compendia, Facta and Briefs of Authorities of the Respondents, and on hearing the submissions of counsel for the parties,

- 1. THIS COURT ORDERS that the appeal is allowed.
- 2. THIS COURT ORDERS that the order of The Honourable Justice Perell of the Ontario Superior Court of Justice dated October 5, 2015 (the "Certification Order") shall be amended as follows:
  - (a) paragraphs 2, 3, 7 and 8 shall include umbrella purchasers in the class definition and a sub-class of non-umbrella purchasers shall be created;
  - (b) paragraph 8(b) shall provide that the aggregate damages issue is certified as common only with respect to the non-umbrella purchaser subclass.
- 3. THIS COURT ORDERS that any issues that arise with respect to the terms of the Certification Order as a result of this decision are to be addressed before the certification judge.
- 4. THIS COURT ORDERS that as agreed by the parties, there is no order as to costs.
